This year the mission work is done with better focus and directions. I had the privilege to visit several underground churches. The spiritual atmosphere was very encouraging. The people expressed their genuine hunger to know God and to learn of Him in order to be effective in their service to God in the midst of occasional supervision from the authorities. However, I do hear some reports about the lack of training to disciple new Christians. The underground churches are less privilege and also having fewer opportunities to grow the church. Nonetheless, they are not deterred but continue to minister to whosoever opens up their hearts to know Christ. Their faith had refreshed me to see deeper into the hearts of those who are willing to do great exploits. The challenges are always there. The Bible training for these people will be conducted every year.

This year, the crowd in Haiphong evidently shows more women having greater tenacity to go against the grain of their atheistic culture. The Hanoi participants consist of younger believers.

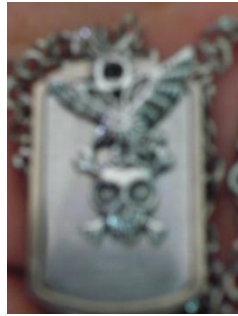
This training is gradually developing into a training centre for these ones who are ready to make their entrance into the ministry... to reach North Vietnam for Jesus.
